- your immediate study plans
- your long-term goals, ambition and motivation
- challenges you have had to deal with
- your availability to attend an interview last week in January

- Copies of ATAR and acceptance to tertiary institution (deferment of attendance for 12 months permissible)
- Information about any other grant or scholarship you have been offered for the coming year
- A letter of support from your school Principal or Year Adviser
